



THE GREAT EXCHANGE OF THE CROSS

ENGAGE IN THE EXCHANGE OF THE CROSS

The simplest way to receive all that Jesus Christ has done for you on the cross is by engaging your mouth and heart in this great exchange - giving Him your weakness and lack and taking His gift of salvation. After you do this, thank God for His salvation gift – His benefits.

Rom. 10:10 *“For with the heart one believes ... and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.”*

1. Jesus was punished and made sin with your sinfulness, so that you could be forgiven and made righteous. (Is. 53:4-5; Is. 53:10; Is. 61:10; II Cor. 5:21; Ps. 103:2)

Exchange: Give Jesus your sins and take His forgiveness and righteousness that He is offering you.

Say: Thank-You Jesus that You have forgiven me of all my sins and made me righteous.

2. Jesus was wounded that you could be healed. (Is. 53:4-5; I Peter 2:24; Ps. 103:2)

Exchange: Give Jesus your sickness and take the healing He is offering you.

Say: Thank-You Jesus that You have healed me of all my sickness.

3. Jesus was made a curse and died your death that you could receive the blessing and share in the life of Christ. (Gal. 3:13-14; Eph. 1:3; Heb. 2:9)

Exchange: Give Jesus any area where you are experiencing the curse and take the blessing that He is offering you.

Say: Thank-You Jesus that You have redeemed me from the curse, from death, and have blessed me with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.

4. Jesus endured your poverty that you could share His abundance. (II Cor. 8:9; 9:8)

Exchange: Give Jesus your poverty, your lack, and take the abundance He is offering you.

Say: Thank-You Jesus that You have given me Your abundance.

5. Jesus bore your shame that you could share His glory. (Matt. 27:35-36, Heb. 12:2; 2:9)

Exchange: Give Jesus your shame, your disgrace, and take the honor and glory He is offering you.

Say: Thank-You Jesus that You have bore my shame and released me from it, allowing me to share in Your honor and glory in this life and in the next.

6. Jesus endured your rejection that you could enjoy His acceptance. (Matt. 27:46-51; Eph. 1:5-6)

Exchange: Give Jesus your rejection and take the acceptance He is offering to you.

Say: Thank-You for being my Father and for accepting me into your family.

7. Jesus was cut off by death that you could be joined to God eternally. (Is. 53:8; I Cor. 6:17)

Exchange: Give to Jesus the things that are separating you from Him and take the oneness that He is offering you.

Say: Thank-You that You allow nothing to separate me from You, having joined me to You eternally

8. Your old man died in Jesus so that Christ could live in you. (Rom. 6:6; Col. 3:9-10; 2 Cor. 5:17)

Exchange: Give to Jesus your old man and put on the new man in Christ Jesus.

Say: Thank-You that You have made me a new creation.

TAKE HOLY COMMUNION

I Cor. 11:23-24 *“and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, ‘Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me.’ In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, ‘This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.’”*

When Jesus Christ tells you to take His body and drink His blood in remembrance of Him, He wants you to take everything He has provided for your salvation as listed below. Remember your faith is based on the His victorious work of the cross that you receive as a gift, not of works.

Eph. 2:8-9 *“For by grace you have been saved through faith and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.”*
