



Session 2 All Qualified to Receive God's SUPER-Natural Love

I. GOD'S SUPERNATURAL LOVE

- A. God's "SUPER-Natural" goes far above and beyond your natural thinking and your natural abilities and ways of receiving and expressing love, superseding all other types of love this world offers.
- B. Love is God's core identity – the essence of Who He is and how He operates. As a believer in Christ, God's "SUPER-Natural" love is your core identity and calling.
- C. Because of God's love being imparted into your heart, you are able to love God with your "all", fulfilling God's first and great commandment and the second commandment, which is like the first - to love others. (Rom. 5:5; John 15:9, John 17:26, Matthew 22:37-40).
- D. Wherever you go, you are called to release God's "SUPER-Natural" love not just with your words but with your actions, just as Jesus did. Jesus said:
- Matthew 10:7-8 And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.' Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.*
- John 14:12 ... he who believes in Me (Jesus), the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.*
- E. Declare – I am made in the image of God's SUPER-Natural love. This is my destiny and my calling. I am called to "heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, and cast out demons." I am called to do the "works" and "greater works" of Jesus.

II. GOD HAS QUALIFIED YOU FOR SALVATION

A. God Has Qualified You Through Jesus' Blood – Colossians 1:12-14

Colossians 1:12-14 giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. 13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love (agape) 14 in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

1. God, your heavenly Father, has qualified you through the blood of His Son Jesus Christ to partake of your inheritance - your salvation - in Christ.
2. What does your inheritance, your salvation, include? (Psalm 103:3-5)
 - a. Eternal Salvation – Justification
 - b. Salvation for every need – Sanctification
3. Continually wearing God's prescriptive lens, the "rose-colored glasses" are crucial in believing, receiving, and ministering God's salvation.
4. You must refuse to wear the dark-colored glasses, which will lead you to believe that you need to qualify yourself for your salvation, your inheritance, based on what you have or have not done.
5. **DECLARE Colossians 1:12-14** for your life or for whom you are praying. Place your answers to these two questions into your declaration.

- a. What inheritance are you believing God for? _____
- b. What are you believing God has delivered you (other person) from? _____

*Colossians 1:12-14 giving thanks to the Father who has qualified **me (name)** to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light (to partake of _____) 13 He has delivered **me (name)** from the power of darkness (from _____) and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love 14 in whom **I (name)** have redemption (from _____) through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.*

B. God Has Qualified You Through Jesus' Blood – Ephesians 2:8

Ephesians 2:8 For by grace you have been saved through faith and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God not of works, lest anyone should boast.

Defining four words from Ephesians 2:8

1. **Saved** comes from the Greek New Testament word “sozo”, which means eternal salvation, heals, restores, delivers, and makes whole. It includes everything that Jesus has provided through His death and resurrection.
2. **Grace** is Jesus – all He is, has done, and has provided. G.R.A.C.E. – **God's Riches At Christ's Expense** – God's unmerited favor.
3. **Gift** - You have been given a gift that you have not qualified yourself for – the gift of Jesus (John 4:10,14) (See [“Jesus is the Gift of God”](#), a blog on the Camarillo Healing Room website.)
4. **Faith** - Grace is not looking for your qualifications but rather it is looking for you to place your faith in Jesus, in Who He is, what He has done through the work of the cross and His sacrificial blood, and what now belongs to you. Because “Faith works through love” Galatians 5:6, immerse yourself in God's unconditional love and watch your faith grow.
6. **DECLARE Ephesians 2:8** for your life or for whom you are praying for.
 - a. Who or what needs God's saving grace? _____ (I, my family, a business, a nation, etc.)
 - b. What aspect of God's salvation are you believing God for? _____ (healing, restoration, deliverance, prosperity, etc.)

Ephesians 2:8 For by grace I (or _____ name the who or what) have been _____ (healed, restored, delivered, etc. from _____) through faith and that not of myself (themselves); (_____ healing, restoration, deliverance, prosperity etc) is the gift of God not of works, lest I (they) should boast.

C. God Has Qualified You Through Jesus' Blood – Jn. 3:16

Jn. 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

According to John 3:16 answer 3 questions:

1. Who is God expressing His love to? To the world, which means each and every person in the world.
2. Why did God give you His only Son? Because "God so loved the world." God placed such great value on every person that He was willing to give up what had the greatest value to Him, His Son. (John 17:23-24)
3. What is everlasting life? The divine life and essence of God Himself. (John 17:3)
4. **DECLARE John 3:16** paraphrased for your life or for whom you are praying for.
 - a. Who or what are you declaring God's SUPER-Natural love over? _____
 - b. What situation – eternal or temporal – are you believing God that you or the person or place you are praying for will not perish of? _____

*For God so loved **me** (name of person, place, business, nation, etc) that He gave **me** (or name) His only begotten Son, so **I** (or name) would not perish eternally nor would **I** (or name) perish here on earth because of _____, but rather that **I** (or name) would experience the abundant life giving power of God.*

III. Testimonies of God's SUPER-Natural Love

A. Healing is a gift of God – part of your inheritance in Jesus Christ.

1. When you hear these testimonies, believe and receive healing for your own body or life or for someone you know. Say "I take it! Thank-You God for this gift of healing!"
2. When you say, "I take it", this means you are receiving the gift of salvation, your inheritance, that God has already purchased for you through the blood of Jesus Christ.
