



How to Stand on the Word of God

for the Fulness of Your Salvation, Your Healing

“We then ... plead with you not to receive the grace of God in vain... Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.” 2 Cor. 6:1-2 Today, God does not want you to miss out on what Jesus Christ has already provided for you through His work of the cross, the fulness of your salvation – the forgiveness of all your sins, the healing of all your diseases, the redemption of your life from the pit of destruction, and the crowning of your life with His lovingkindness and tender mercies. (Psalm 103:3-4)

How can you receive the fulness of your salvation, which was purchased for you by Jesus’ precious blood? By asking in prayer and believing you have received it, when you prayed. (Mark 11:24) You receive the blessing of your salvation first in the spirit realm and then in the natural realm. Sometimes, the manifestation in the natural realm occurs instantly. And, at other times the manifestation occurs hours, days, weeks or months later, as you continue to believe and hold fast the confession of your faith. (Rom. 10:8-10; Heb. 10:23) Do not allow the delay to cause you to doubt.

Doubt – Do Without

Doubting is wavering between the Truth of God’s Word and the natural facts. In the area of healing, the facts and symptoms may declare you are sick; but God’s Word declares you were healed by Jesus’ stripes. (1 Peter 2:24) The enemy tries to gain a foothold in your thinking, by causing you to question God’s Word, what legally belongs to you as God’s child. The enemy wants you to believe that “you are not healed” and “you will never get well.”

You have a choice, just as Adam and Eve did, of whose words you will accept, believe, confess, and obey. Elijah said to the Israelites, “How long will you falter (waver) between two opinions? If the LORD is God, follow Him; but if Baal (satan), follow him.” 1 Kings 18:21

God Word exhorts you to not waver. “But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.” Jm. 1: 6-7

A double-minded man wavers between two minds: the mind of Christ, God’s Word, and the mind of satan, his words. To receive God’s Word, you must keep satan’s thoughts and opinion, his negative words, out of your heart and mind.

So, what do you do when a thought or a mental picture comes knocking at the door of your mind that goes against God’s Word for your salvation, for your healing or victory? You need to deny its entrance into your thought life, thereby rendering it powerless to influence you, “casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ. 2 Cor. 10:5 You cannot afford to entertain any word that contradicts God’s Word.



Strengthen Your Faith

When Abraham and Sarah were given God's Word that they would bear children, they chose to believe it, despite all the contradicting natural evidence. "And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb. He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform." Romans 4:19-20 What Abraham chose to do as He waited for God's spoken Word to come to pass is what you will need to do, if you desire God's Word to prevail in your life.

Do not consider or fix your thoughts on how impossible your situation is. Abraham and Sarah's bodies were way past childbearing age. Therefore, if you are sick, don't get discouraged, if your body is way beyond its natural ability to recover or beyond a cure from the medical profession. If you have another impossible situation that contradicts God's salvation for your life, don't give up trusting God.

Instead, fix your thoughts on God and His Word, what already exists in the spirit realm, and begin praising and thanking God for His provision, for your salvation and healing. As you glorify God, paying attention to His Word, Your faith will be strengthened.

Come into Agreement with God's Word, His Will

The New Testament is God's written "will" for you. It is not signed with ink, but with the blood of His Son, Jesus. Come into agreement with God's Word, His will, and act upon it, just as you would a legal will or trust, possessing what rightfully belongs to you.

Pray "that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him (His Word - His way and will), the eyes of your understanding being enlightened..." Ephesians 1:17 -18

Meditate on God's Word, the fulness of your salvation, your healing. Think about what He has said and put His words into your heart and mouth. (See Joshua 1:8)

Declare God's Word having your mouth work for you and not against you. If you need healing,

1. Take a few Bible verses from "Healing Scriptures" and begin declaring them out loud daily.
2. Personalize the healing scriptures by putting your name of "I" in the verse. Example: "By His stripes (your name or "I") was healed." 1 Peter 2:24.
3. Picture Jesus Himself standing in front of you speaking His Word over you. Example: "By My stripes you are healed." 1 Peter 2:24
4. Set a date when you believed you have received your salvation, your healing. (Mk. 11:24)
5. When satan tempts you to doubt, declare "It is written...(insert scripture)," just as Jesus did. (Mt. 4:4-10)
6. If you desire to experience the fulness of your salvation in any other area, follow the above steps.
