

Standing on the Word of God

for the Fulness of Your Salvation – Your Healing

2 Corinthian 6:1-2 "We then ... plead with you not to receive the grace of God in vain... Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation."

Today, God does not want you to miss out on what Jesus Christ has already provided for you through His work of the cross. God exhorts you to receive the fulness of His grace for your salvation – for the forgiveness of your sins, the healing of all your diseases, the redemption of your life from the pit of destruction, and the crowning of your life with His lovingkindness and tender mercies. (Psalm 103:3-4)

Mark 11:24 "Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them."

How can you receive the fulness of your salvation — what Jesus Christ has purchased for you with His precious blood? Through believing that you have received your request, when you prayed. You receive the blessing of your salvation first in the spirit realm. And then, through faith or the confession of your faith, you receive it in the natural realm. (Romans 10:8-10) Sometimes, the manifestation in the natural realm occurs instantly. And, at other times the manifestation occurs hours, days, weeks or months later, as you continue to hold fast the confession of your faith without wavering. (Heb. 10:23) Do not allow the delay to cause you to doubt.

Doubt – Do Without

Doubting is wavering between the Truth of God's Word and the natural facts. In the area of healing, the facts and symptoms may declare you are sick; but God's Word declares you were healed by Jesus' stripes. (1 Peter 2:24) The enemy tries to gain a foothold in your thinking, by causing you to question God's Word, what legally belongs to you as God's child. The enemy wants you to believe that "you are not healed" and "you will never get well."

You have a choice, just as Adam and Eve did, of whose words you will accept, believe, and obey. Elijah said to the Israelites, "How long will you falter (waver) between two opinions? If the LORD is God, follow Him; but if Baal (satan), follow him." 1 Kings 18:21

God Word exhorts you not to doubt. "But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways." Jm. 1: 6-7



A double-minded man wavers between two minds: the mind of Christ, God's Word - His thoughts and opinions, and the mind of satan, his words - his thoughts and opinions. To receive from the Lord, you must keep doubt out of your mind, out of your beliefs.

So, what do you do when a thought or a mental picture comes knocking at the door of your mind that goes against God's Word for your healing or victory? You need to deny its entrance into your thought life, thereby rendering it powerless to influence you, "casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ. 2 Cor. 10:5

You need to get rid of any thought, feeling, impression, image, suggestion, vision or dream is trying to gain entrance into your mind and heart, which does not come into agreement with what God's Word says about your salvation, your healing. You cannot afford to entertain for even one moment any thought that contradicts God's Word.

Strengthen Your Faith

Abraham and Sarah were given God's Word that they would bear children. From the perspective of natural facts and reasoning, God's Word to them was unbelievable. What Abraham chose to do in the waiting period, between God's spoken Word to them and the Word coming to pass, is what you will need to choose to do, if you desire God's Word to prevail in your life.

Romans 4:19-20 "And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb. He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform."

Do not consider or fix your thoughts on how impossible your situation is. The power to produce the promise was not in Abraham and Sarah's natural abilities; their bodies were "dead." So, don't get discouraged, if your body is beyond its natural ability to recover or for the medical profession to help you.

Instead, fix your thoughts on God and His Word, what already exists in the spirit realm, and begin praising and thanking God for the fulness of your salvation, for your healing. This will cause your faith to be strengthened.

Take God's Word as your Final Authority

The New Testament is God's written "will" for you. It is not signed with ink, but with the blood of His Son, Jesus. Act upon God's Words, as you would a legal will or trust, possessing what rightfully belongs to you.



Pray: "that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him the eyes of your understanding being enlightened..." Ephesians 1:17 -18

Meditate: "...meditate on it day and night...for then you will have good success." Joshua 1:8

Meditate on God's Word, thinking and speaking It all day. God wants you to meditate on what He has said in His Word about your salvation, your healing, not on what your flesh or the world is telling you.

Declare: Boldly declare God's Word, His Truth, having your mouth work for you and not against you. For healing:

- 1. Take a few Bible verses from "Healing Scriptures" and begin to declare them out loud over and over again.
- 2. Personalize the healing scriptures by putting the personal pronoun "I" or your name in the verse as you declare them out loud. Ie "*By His stripes* (I or your name) *was healed.*" *I Peter 2:24*.
- 3. Picture Jesus Himself standing in front of you and saying: "By My stripes you were healed." 1 Peter 2:24
- 4. Set a date when you believed you have received the fullness of your salvation, your healing. (Mk. 11:24)
- 5. When satan tempts you to doubt, declare, "It is written...(insert scripture)," just as Jesus did.
- Use the above declaration example to receive the fulness of your salvation for any area of your life.
