

HEALING SCRIPTURES

If your health has been suffering, listen to the words of your Great Physician, Jehovah Rapha. (Ex. 15:26) He has prescribed the perfect medicine, His Words, for you to overcome any health issue you are facing.

Proverbs 4:20-22 My son, give attention to My Words. Incline your ear to My sayings. Do not let them depart from your eyes. Keep them in the midst of your heart. For they are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh.

Declare the following healing scriptures, out loud daily, allowing God's Word to flow into your eye and ear gates and down into the depths of your heart. As you do this, you will experience the healing effects of God's medicine for all your flesh. Take 3 times per day or as often as needed.

Jesus Paid for Your Healing

Exodus 15:26 For I am the Lord who heals you.

Jesus is Your Great Physician.

Isaiah 53:1,4-5 Who has believed our report? ...Surely He has borne our griefs (sicknesses and diseases) and carried our sorrows (pains, afflictions). He was wounded for our transgressions. He was bruised for our iniquities. The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His (Jesus) stripes we are healed.

The Hebrew word for healed is raphe, which means to cure, make whole, to mend.

Matthew 8:16-17 He (Jesus) cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses."

The Hebrew word for bore is *nasa*, which means to carry away, bear up, lift, or cast away. Jesus bore your sickness, so you would not need to bear it.

1 Peter 2:24 Who Himself (Jesus) bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness - by whose stripes you were healed.

Jesus bore your sicknesses at the same time and in the same way that He bore your sins.

Colossians 2:14-15 (God) having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.

Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.

In Christ you have been given the verdict – not guilty. All claims of justice against you have been settled by Jesus’ blood.

Leviticus 17:11 for the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul.

Psalm 105:37 He also brought them out (of Egypt)...and there was none feeble (sick) among His tribes.

Leaving Egypt there was not one Israelite of 2-3 million that were sick, because they ate the Passover Lamb the night before.

1 Corinthians 5:7 For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed.

Luke 22:15 Jesus said, “With fervent desire I have desired to eat the Passover with you before I suffer.”

Jesus’ fervent desire was to give you the Passover, Himself.

1 Corinthians 11:24-25 and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, “Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me.” In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.”

Jesus wants you to take and eat what He gave to you: His body and blood, for the healing of your body and for the forgiveness of your sins.

Psalms 103:1-2 Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits; Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases...

Psalm 69:15 ...who daily loads us with benefits.

Healing is one of the benefits given to you. It is part of your redemptive birthright.

Galatians 3:13-14 Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree”) that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

To redeem means to liberate or rescue from captivity or bondage, or from any obligation to suffer, by paying an equivalent penalty. Deut. 28:15-61 Lists the curses of the law, the



sicknesses, that Christ has redeemed you from, including “every serious and prolonged sickness” vs.59 and “every sickness and every plague, which is not written in the book of the law” vs. 61.

God Wants You Well

Jeremiah 29:11 (NLT) For I know the plans I have for you says the Lord. They are plans for good and not for disaster to give you a future and a hope.

God is a good God. Healing is part of His good plans for you. In Christ you have a bright future and hope.

John 10:10 The thief (satan) does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I (Jesus) have come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

The thief tries to steal one’s health, while Christ came to give you His divine health.

Acts 10:38 God anointed Jesus with the Holy Spirit and with power, Who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

Jesus perfectly demonstrated God’s heart by healing all who came to Him.

1 John 3:8 The Son of God appeared that He might destroy the works of the devil.

Sicknesses are some of the works of the devil that Jesus destroyed.

Matthew 8: 2-3 Lord if you are willing...I (Jesus) am willing be cleansed (healed).

Jesus’ will for the leper is His will for you today.

Luke 4:18-19 The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor. He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.

Jesus’ mission statement for humanity has not changed.

Romans 8:32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things.

God desires that you receive divine health, which is part of the “all things” that He has purchased for you.



Matthew 7:11 If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!

3 John 2 Beloved I pray that you prosper and be in good health just as your soul prospers.

Jesus Still Heals

Romans 1:16 The gospel is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes...

God's power to save your body, soul, and spirit is released to you as you believe and apply the message of the cross to your own life.

Ephesians 2:8 For by grace you have been saved through faith and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God.

The Greek word for saved is "sozo": saved, healed, made whole.

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

Jesus still saves and heals all who come to Him in faith, just as He did in His earthly ministry.

Matthew 12:15 And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all.

Luke 4: 40 All those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and He laid His hands on every one of them and healed them.

Luke 6:19 And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and healed them all.

You are not excluded from being healed. You are part of that "all" in the crowd.

Now is the Time

Exodus 23:25 And I will take sickness away from the midst of you.

Jeremiah 30:17 For I will restore health to you and heal you of your wounds.

The Old Testament looked forward to the cross, saying "I will heal you".

In the New Testament, *"He (Jesus) Himself took our infirmities."* *Matthew 8:17*

You do not need to put your healing into the future because God put it into the past tense. *John 19:30 It is finished.*



Mark 11:24...when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.

2 Corinthians 6:2 Behold, now is the acceptable time. Behold, now is the day of salvation (healing).

Matthew 6:11 Give us this day our daily bread.

Healing is your daily bread.

Hebrews 3:7 Today, if you hear His voice (His healing word), do not harden your hearts.

Faith and Prayer

Romans 10:17 Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.

Galatians 3:5 He, Who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you, does He do it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?

Hebrews 11:1,6 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen... Without faith it is impossible to please Him.

2 Corinthians 5:7 For we walk by faith, not by sight.

Mark 5:36 Do not be afraid; only believe.

Mark 9:23 If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes.

Romans 4:19-20 And not being weak in faith, he (Abraham) did not consider his own body already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb. He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God.

Abraham did not look at his circumstances. Instead, he kept his eyes only on what God said to him. Keep your eyes on I Peter 2:24 – God's word for your circumstance.

Heb. 10:23 Let us hold fast the confession of our faith without wavering because He is faithful.

Ephesians 6:16 ... above all taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.

The darts of the wicked one are sent to cause you to question God's Word.

Ephesians 1:19 that you may know the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe...

Matthew 17:21 However, this kind (of unbelief) does not go out except by prayer and fasting.

1 John 5:14,15 Now, this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

Healing is always His will.

The Word of God is Spirit and Life

Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him Who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He Who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit Who dwells in you.

John 6:63 It is the Spirit Who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit and life.

Hebrews 4:12 The word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword...

Ephesians 6:17 And take...the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.

Philippians 4:8 whatever things are true... noble...just...pure...lovely... of good report... meditate (think) on these things.

Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony...

Isaiah 33:24 And (you) will not say, "I am sick."

Your testimony is God's Word, the Truth of 1 Peter 2:24: "By His stripes you were healed".
