

I. See Yourself as Jesus Now Is

As a believer, Jesus' resurrected identity is your resurrected identity.

1 John 4:17 ... because as He is, so are we in this world.

Ephesians 1:20-21 God raised Jesus from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come.

II. Four Core Realities of Your Resurrected Identity

A. New Creation In Christ

1. The moment you invited Jesus Christ into your heart as your Lord and Savior a miracle of miracles took place. You became a new creation in Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

- Your old darkened sin-stained identity in the first Adam perished or ceased to exist.
- God's power was released into your human spirit, making you into a new creation in Christ, where all things have become new.

2. Because the power of hell could not keep Jesus, the Righteous One, in the grave, it is impossible for the power of hell to keep you or anyone else, who calls upon Jesus' name to be saved, in the grip of death, living under the tyranny of the kingdom of darkness and under satan's dominion.

Acts 2:24 ...whom God raised up, having loosed the pains of death, because it was not possible that He should be held by it.

3. The precious blood of Jesus Christ poured out for you through the work of the cross made this new creation miracle possible. (Eph. 1:7; Col. 1:13-14; Rom. 5:9)

1 Peter 1:18-19 knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things... but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

4. Operating in your resurrection identity, begins by beholding Christ and by beholding who you are in Christ, because of Jesus' finished work of the cross. Behold = to see by faith. (See 2 Cor. 3:18)

*John 1:29 **Behold!** The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!*

*Revelation 1:18 I am He who lives, and was dead, and **behold**, I am alive forevermore*

*2 Cor. 5:17 ...**behold**, all things have become new.*

5. "All things" have become new. (John 16:15, Luke 15:31, 2 Peter 1:3-4, Romans 8:32)

B. Made Alive, Raised Up, and Seated in Heavenly Places in Christ

1. Natural Birth - Your spirit man was once dead. By no choice of your own through natural birth you were born spiritually dead into Adam's family via the fall. (Colossians 2:13, Ephesians 2:1)

Spiritual Rebirth - Now by your choice by inviting Jesus Christ into your heart, you have gone through a spiritual rebirth and you have been made alive in Christ Jesus.

1 Corinthians 15:22 For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all shall be made alive.

2. How was this made possible that you went from being spiritually dead to being made spiritually alive? It was through the blood of Jesus. (Ephesians 1:7; Romans 5:9)

Leviticus 17:11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul.'

3. As a believer you have been made alive with the life of God Himself. The word for “life” in Greek is “zoe,” which is the life of God Himself - all He is and all He has.

John 10:10 The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

John 14:19 Because I live, you will live also.

4. When you were made a new creation in Christ, Jesus’ “life-giving spirit” (1 Cor. 15:45)

- made you alive in Christ.
- raised you up together with Christ.
- made you co-seated with Christ in the heavenly places.

Ephesians 2:4-6 But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ ... and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.

6. No matter what you are facing, hear Jesus’ words from Revelation 1:18. Do not be afraid! See Jesus “The Resurrection and The Life” (Jn. 11:25) operating in you and through you. See your salvation!

Revelation 1:18 “Do not be afraid... I am He Who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. AMEN. And I have the keys of Hades and of Death.”

C. Made Righteous in Christ

1. You are a triune being made of three parts - spirit, soul, and body.

1 Thessalonians 5:23 ... may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ

2. When you were born again, you were born with righteousness for your nature, the very nature of God Himself. Being “made righteous” is what took place within your spirit.

Romans 5:19 For as by one man’s disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man’s obedience many will be made righteous.

3. Righteousness is the core reality of being a new creation in Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:21 For He made Him (Jesus) who knew no sin to be sin for us that we might become the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus.

4. Jesus’ robe of righteousness which He has given to you was purchased by His own precious blood. His righteousness has qualified you to receive all “the garments of salvation” (Ps. 103:3-5); every spiritual blessing (Eph. 1:3); and all His grace (Eph. 2:7). (See also Luke 15:22, 31)

Isaiah 61:10 For He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness.

5. By receiving the gift of righteousness and the abundance of His grace – your resurrected identity - you are able to reign in life through Jesus Christ.

Romans 5:17 *For if by the one man’s offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.*

6. What does “made righteous” mean? It means that your spirit was made holy as Jesus is Holy. The Holy Spirit could not dwell in you, if your spirit was not made 100% righteous and holy.

Hebrews 10:14 *For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified.*

Colossians 1:22 In Christ God sees you as *“holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight.”*

7. Righteousness is your new name, your new resurrected identity in Christ.

Jeremiah 23:6 *Now this is His name by which He will be called: The Lord our righteousness.*

Jeremiah 33:16 *In those days Judah will be saved and Jerusalem will dwell safely. And this is the name by which she will be called: The Lord our righteousness.*

Declare: I believe the declaration God made of His Son that He is righteous.

And, I believe the declaration God made of me because of His Son. I am righteous.

8. You are called to view yourself and others not by who you are in the flesh but by the spirit.

2 Corinthians 5:16 *Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him thus no longer.*

D. Received a New Spirit and Made One Spirit with Him

1. You received a new spirit, the Spirit of truth, the anointing.

Ezekiel 36:26-27 *I...will put a new spirit within you...I will put My Spirit within you...*

John 14:17 (Jesus prophesied) *The Spirit of truth... will be in you.*

1 John 2:27 *But the anointing, which you have received from Him, abides in you...*

2. You became one spirit with Him.

1 Corinthians 6:17 *But he who is joined to the Lord is one spirit with Him.*

3. You are a dwelling place for God’s Spirit.

1 Corinthians 6:19 *... do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit Who is in you, Whom you have from God, and you are not your own?*

4. The real you is who you are in your recreated spirit, where the fullness of the Godhead dwells.

Col. 2:9-10 *For in Him (Christ) dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; and you are complete in Him, Who is the head of all principality and power.*

III. Unleash Your Resurrected Identity - Authority and Power

A. Kingdom Authority

1. After Jesus Christ’s resurrection from the dead, He appeared to the disciples, saying.

Mt. 28:18 *“All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.”*

2. Christ, “the anointed King” - the King of kings, is now living in you. He has made you a king under Him, the One Who is the King of kings.

Revelation 19:16 Jesus Christ’s name: *“King of kings and Lord of lords.”*

Revelation 1:6 ... and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father.

3. Jesus primarily released His authority through the words He spoke. And this is primarily how you release His authority – by speaking His name, His Word.

John 14:10 Jesus said, **“Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.”**

B. Filled with God’s Power

1. God has given you not only authority but power to do the works of Jesus. (Luke 9:1; 10:19)
2. Your state of powerlessness has passed away because the fulness of the Godhead lives in you. (Col. 2:9-10)
3. You are anointed like Jesus with the Holy Spirit and power to do good and heal all. (Matthew 10:1)
Acts 10:38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.
4. The power of God in you, His resurrection power, is greater than the power of sin, sickness, and destruction.

1 John 4:4 You are of God little children and have overcome them, because He Who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

- a. You have power over sin. *Romans 6:14 For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.*
 - b. You have power over sickness. *Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.*
 - c. You have power over “them” - the world, flesh, and the devil. *1 John 4:4*
5. In Christ you are able to do the works of Jesus and the greater works.
John 14:12 Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

6. How do you access this power?

Galatians 3:5 He who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you, does He do it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?

III. Walk with a Conscious Awareness of Your Resurrected Identity

A. Jesus Walked with a Conscious Awareness of His Identity

1. Jesus stood in His identity as He confronted death and says: *“I am the resurrection and the life.”*
John 11:25 Then He unleashes His identity decreeing: *“Lazarus, come forth!”* *John 11:43*

2. Jesus seeing the spiritual forces of darkness ruling over the man born blind from birth stands in His identity and declares: “As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.” *John 9:5*

B. Paul Walked with a Conscious Awareness of His Resurrected Identity

1. Paul deeply understood and walked with a conscious awareness of his new identity in Christ – His resurrected identity – the newness of life.

Galatians 2:20-21 I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live; but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God Who loved me and gave Himself for me. I do not set aside the grace of God, for if righteousness comes through the law, Christ died in vain.

Romans 6:4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

2. Paul’s intimate knowledge of God’s love and grace made him determined “to know nothing except for Jesus Christ and Him crucified.” *1 Corinthians 2:2*
3. Paul knew his true identity now and for all eternity was “in Christ” – in the glorified resurrected Christ. Because of God’s great love shown to him through the power of the cross (Christ’s death, burial, resurrection and ascension) Paul’s heart was steadied through all that he faced. *Romans 8:32-39*

C. You are Called to Walk with a Conscious Awareness of Your Resurrected Identity

1. You need to reckon like Paul did that you are no longer who you once were, presenting yourself to God as “being alive from the dead.”

Romans 6:11, 13 Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord... but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead.

2. “Putting on the new man” involves walking with a conscious awareness of your resurrected identity – your righteousness and holiness in Christ.

Ephesians 4:24 and that you put on the new man which was created according to God in true righteousness and holiness.

3. It is not about faking it until you make it. But rather, it is accepting the substitutionary work of the cross as your own and living from the present tense reality that as Christ is in His resurrected state, so are you now in this world. (*1 John 4:17*)
